THE IRISH PEST MANAGEMENT CPE WORKSHOP GROUP

The CPE workshop group was formed to provide the Irish Pest Management Industry with a means by which CPE (Continuous Professional Education) can be attained at low cost throughout the Republic of Ireland. These workshops will earn A Class CPE Credits and will contribute greatly toward the credit totals required to maintain PMU registration with DAFM. Other means of earning CPE credits are available on the IASIS website WWW/IASIS.IE

Workshops will be delivered at four regional centres throughout the year: Munster, Connaught and Leinster.

- **Places must be booked and fees paid in advance of the workshop date. Dates for closure of bookings will be communicated to all interested parties**
- **Workshops must have a minimum of 10 attendees to proceed**
- **Fees will be refunded in the event of the minimum attendance not being reached**
- **Maximum number of attendees is 15 per course**
